USTA AGE ELIGIBILITY

MONTH OF BIRTH AGE ELIGIBILITY: The USTA has adopted a “month of birth” age eligibility rule for junior players competing in USTA sanctioned tournaments. This rule applies to all local, District, Sectional, and National USTA sanctioned tournaments – it does not apply to ITF tournaments (see “ITF Tournament Information” on page 13). Junior players may continue to play in the 12, 14, 16 and 18 age divisions until the month they turn 13, 15, 17, or 19, respectively. Players should use the starting date of a tournament to determine eligibility when a tournament begins in one month and ends in the next.

SETTING GOALS: All junior players are responsible for setting their own competitive goals and meeting the requirements for tournaments, ranking, and endorsement.

PLANNING AHEAD: All junior players should plan ahead and consult their parents, coaches, or their Sectional Office to help them decide which age group is best for them to play in order to meet their tennis development and ranking goals.

ENTERING TOURNAMENTS ON THE NATIONAL JUNIOR TOURNAMENT SCHEDULE

Tournaments listed in this booklet will use different methods of entry. Below are descriptions of the various types of entry methods. The entry method type for an individual tournament will be shown as part of the listing for the tournament in this booklet.

TENNISLINK

- **Tournaments Using Tennis Link:**
 - USTA National Championships;
 - USTA National Opens;
 - USTA Boys’ and Girls’ 18 Interscholastic Championships (East/West)
 - Various other tournaments on the National Junior Tournament Schedule – see individual tournament listings in this booklet and check online at www.USTA.com (click on Tournaments).
- **Read Tournament Information BEFORE Entering:** READ THE INFORMATION PROVIDED BY THE TOURNAMENT BEFORE ENTERING. Tournaments will provide entrants with important information about the tournament on the Tournament Home Page. Be sure to visit a tournament’s individual website (if a link is provided) and scroll down and read all of the notes provided by the tournament.
- **Entry Deadlines: DO NOT WAIT UNTIL THE LAST MINUTE TO REGISTER! NO LATE ENTRIES ARE ACCEPTED.** Entries close on the entry deadline day at **12:00 pm (noon) Eastern Time** for ALL tournaments listed in the National Junior Tournament Schedule Booklet. Entry deadlines are printed with the information on each tournament in this booklet and on the TennisLink Tournament Home Page for each tournament.
- **Entering Using TennisLink:** Generally, registration opens six weeks prior to the entry deadline. Check this booklet and the TennisLink Tournament Home Page for the dates entries open and close. Entry is made directly by the junior player (or user) into the tournament using TennisLink. Go to www.USTA.com and click on Tournaments & Leagues/Juniors Tournaments/Schedule to reach the Searchable Schedule. To reach the TennisLink Tournament Home page, use the features of the Searchable Schedule. Once at the Tournament Home Page, follow the directions to enter. You will need your USTA number and a credit card to make payment. If you do not have access to the internet or a credit card, contact the Tournament Director for assistance with entering.
- **Confirmation Number:** Upon completion of the registration process, you will receive a confirmation number that indicates a successful registration. This number does NOT mean you have been accepted into the tournament. **For tournaments on the National Junior**

Tournament Schedule, selection and acceptance notification occurs after the entry deadline. It is your responsibility to check the applicant list for your name AND, in the case of USTA National Championships and USTA National Opens, also check the selection process list for a checkmark next to your name to confirm successful completion of the registration process. If you are unable to confirm your registration within 3-4 hours after submitting your registration, email linkteam@usta.com.

- **Online Assistance:** If you are having trouble using TennisLink, contact the LinkTeam at linkteam@usta.com. An additional online resource is the TennisLink Tutorial.
- **Payment of Entry Fee:** In tournaments with a selection process (such as the USTA National Championships and USTA National Opens), your credit card will not be charged until the selection has been done. Players who are alternates will not be charged. If alternates get into a tournament, they will have to pay their entry fee at the time of acceptance in a method acceptable to the tournament. For tournaments without a selection procedure (some Level 3 tournaments), your entry fee will be charged at the time of entry.
- **Withdrawal from Tournament and Refund of Entry Fee:** The Tournament Committee shall refund a player's entry fee if the entry is not accepted or if the player withdraws no later than seven days before the start of the tournament. No refund is required beginning six days before the start of the tournament. As soon as possible, the player shall notify the Referee in writing of the player's withdrawal and the reason therefore.
- **Selection for Tournaments:** See "USTA National Championships" on page 8 and "USTA National Opens" on page 11 for information on selection notification. See TennisLink Tournament Home Page for other tournaments on selection notification.

SECTIONAL SELECTION: Junior players are selected by their Section to represent the Section in the team tournaments listed below. Sections have varying methods for players to enter – contact your Section for information on entering.

NATIONAL STANDINGS LIST (NSL)

DEFINITION: Singles National Standings Lists (NSLs) for singles and doubles are published at least monthly for each division using the results below. It is anticipated that NSLs will be published as frequently as once a week. NSLs are used for various purposes including selecting players into limited draw tournaments, ordering alternates, and as a guide for seeding. (See "USTA National Championships" on page 8 and "USTA National Opens" on page 11)

ELIGIBILITY: An NSL for a division will include all age eligible players who have played at least one National Ranking Tournament in the division and have accumulated at least 1 point.

RESULTS: NSLs are calculated using the 8 best National Ranking Tournaments for each player during the previous 12-month period based on the points per round ranking system. See “USTA National Junior Rankings” on page 14 for a description of the points per round system and for the table of National Ranking Tournaments. Points earned in a higher age division tournament count towards a player’s standing in one or more younger age divisions.

This means that a 12 year old playing some in the 12s, but primarily in the 14s, occasionally in the 18s and not at all in the 16s will appear on the 12s, 14s and 18s National Standings Lists, so long as the player accumulated 1 point that count in each division, but not on the 16s National Standings List. It also means that a 12 year old playing only in the 16s and occasionally in the 18s will appear on the 16s and 18s National Standings Lists, so long as the player accumulated 1 point that count in each division, but not on the 12s and 14s National Standings Lists.

TIEBREAK RULES FOR NSLs: Tiebreaks on a NSL will be determined as follows:

1. A player whose best event has the highest number of points, second best, third best, etc. through eight events.
2. Total Bonus Points earned in all events played during the computation period.
3. Best random draw number

USTA NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

DEFINITION – The USTA National Championships are the highest level of USTA national junior competition. Four USTA National Championships are held each year in each division: USTA National Spring Championships, USTA National Clay Court Championships, The USTA National Championships, and USTA National Winter Championships.

ELIGIBILITY: Players who meet the U.S. citizenship or residency requirements, age eligibility requirements, and membership requirements (current USTA membership) may enter. In addition, professional players may enter. The USTA National Championships are the only type of USTA junior national championship that professional players can enter.

ENTRY PROCEDURES – Players must enter using TennisLink. See “Entering Tournaments on the National Junior Tournament Schedule” on page 4. A player may enter only one USTA National Championship that is scheduled to take place at the same time. For example, a player may not enter the USTA Girls’ 16 Winter National Championships and the USTA Girls’ 18 Winter National Championships in the hope of making it into at least one. Players who are entered in more than one USTA National Championship at the time entries close will not be accepted into either tournament and will receive suspension points.

DOUBLES ENTRY PROCEDURES - The entry deadline for the doubles event at USTA National Opens is on the day of registration and the time is set by the Tournament Committee - see the TennisLink Tournament Home Page for information. At USTA National Championships that have more than one division (the USTA Winter Championships, for example, that has the BG18 and 16 at one location), players must play doubles in the same division in which they are playing singles.

SINGLES SELECTION PROCEDURE – Each Tournament Committee shall accept players into the draws of USTA National Championships in the following order:

- **Players on National Championship Selection List (NCSL):** The following junior players on the NCSL who have submitted timely entries shall be accepted into the draw:
 Players listed in positions 1 through 24 for a draw of 192
 Players listed in positions 1 through 16 for a draw of 128
 See “National Championship Selection List” below for the criteria for appearing on this list.
- **Players Who Qualified from USTA National Opens:** Top three singles finishers in each of the four preceding USTA National Opens who have submitted timely entries shall be accepted. In addition, the doubles finalists at each of the four preceding USTA National Opens who have submitted timely entries shall be accepted into the doubles draw and shall be singles

alternates if they have not already been accepted into the singles draw. National Open singles and doubles qualifiers do not need Sectional endorsement for acceptance. (Note: The lower place finishers do not gain entry under this process even if one of the qualifiers fails to enter, is not age eligible for the tournament, or achieves entry by another procedure.)

USTA National Open	Qualifies for the following USTA National Championship:
February National Opens	USTA National Spring Championships
May National Opens	USTA National Clay Court Championships
July National Opens	The USTA National Championships
November National Opens	USTA National Winter Championships

- **Players within Sectional Associations' Quotas:** Junior players not previously selected who are on the Sectional endorsement lists, within the established Sectional quota, and who have submitted timely entries shall be accepted in the order determined by the Sectional endorser.
- **Wild Cards:** The Tournament Committee shall accept those junior players granted wild cards by the USTA Wild Card Committee and who have submitted timely entries. Wild card recipients do not need Sectional endorsement, however the Sectional office must complete a portion of a player's wild card application. See "USTA Junior National Wild Card Regulations" on page 11. Overall wild card limits are:
Four (4) wild cards for the 14s, 16s and 18s USTA National Spring Championships and USTA Winter Championships and for all 12s USTA National Championships.
Eight (8) wild cards for the 14s, 16s and 18s USTA National Clay Court Championships and The USTA National Championships.
- **Endorsed players on National Standings List:** The Tournament Committee shall fill remaining spots in the draw with endorsed players who have submitted timely entries who remain on the most recently published singles National Standings List. See "National Standings List" on page 7.

SINGLES ALTERNATES:

- **Alternate List:** The Tournament Committee shall prepare an alternate list of those players with timely entries not accepted into the draw who appear on the Sectional Endorsement Lists and who are doubles finalists from the four preceding USTA National Opens. Alternates shall be ordered using the National Standings List used to accept players into the draw to fill remaining vacancies.
- **Replacement of Player Before Draw is Made:** The Tournament Committee shall replace a player who was accepted as part of a Section's quota with the next player on that Section's endorsement list. The Tournament Committee shall replace a player who was NOT accepted as part of a Section's quota with next highest remaining alternate.
- **Replacement of Player After Draw is Made, but Before the Completion of the First Round:** The Tournament Committee shall replace a player after the draw is made, but before the completion of the first round with next highest remaining alternate.
- **No Replacement of Players is Made After the Completion of the First Round:** No players are replaced in the draw after the completion of the first round. For example, a player who wins their first round, but can not play their second round due to injury, is NOT replaced with an alternate.

SINGLES SELECTION NOTIFICATION: The players and their acceptance status will be published to the TennisLink Tournament Home Page shortly after the entries close. Go to www.USTA.com, click on Tournaments & Leagues/Juniors Tournaments/Schedule and locate the tournament using the Searchable Schedule. Wild card recipients will be notified by the USA Tennis Junior Competition Department. Alternates selected to fill openings in the draw will be contacted by the Tournament Committee.

NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP SELECTION LIST (NCSL): The USTA shall publish to www.USTA.com an NCSL for each division with effective dates as of January 15, May 1, and

October 1. Sectional endorsement is not required to appear on a NCSL. Each list shall consist of players who are age eligible for the subsequent USTA National Championship as follows:

- players who have an ATP singles ranking of 1000 or better or who have a WTA singles ranking of 600 or better as of the effective date - these players shall be listed in the order of their ranking and shall be placed at the top of the list;
- players not previously listed who have an ITF singles ranking of 100 or better as of the effective date – these players shall be listed in the order of their ranking and shall be placed directly below the first group of players; and
- players not previously listed who have (1) played in at least one National Ranking Tournament (see page 15 for the list of these tournaments) in the list's division during the 4 months before the effective date of the NCSL, and (2) at least two other National Ranking Tournaments in the list's division during the 12 months before the list effective date of the list. These players shall be listed in order of their strength of singles record calculated as of the effective date in the same manner as the National Standings List and shall be placed directly below the second group of players.

Note that the May 1 NCSL is used for both the USTA National Clay Court Championships and The USTA National Championships, except that immediately after the USTA National Clay Court Championships the list is republished and any players who are not age eligible for The USTA National Championships are removed and replaced with the next-highest player.

Administrative Errors: Junior players who do not appear on the NCSL due to administrative error may request a correction to the list. Requests should be sent to the Coordinator of USTA Junior Rankings, Mitchel Alpert, 732-974-9149 (H), 732-974-9184 (Fax), alpertmb@aol.com. Requests must be postmarked or e-mail time stamped within 10 days of the publication of NCSL.

USTA NATIONAL JUNIOR WILD CARD REGULATIONS

EVENTS – Wild cards are granted for the USTA National Championships and certain ITF tournaments. The information below applies ONLY to wild cards for USTA National Championships. Contact the individual tournament directors for information on ITF wild cards.

ELIGIBILITY – Applications for wild cards will be considered in extreme cases where extenuating circumstances have made the normal procedure of qualification and endorsement impossible. Wild cards also may be granted based on the recommendation of the USTA National Coaching Staff that a player has demonstrated significant potential at the national and international level.

APPLICATIONS – Wild card applications are available through your Sectional office and on the USTA web page. The application includes a request for supporting documents and has a section that must be completed by the Sectional office. The player is responsible for submitting the application to the Director of USTA Junior Competition. See "Contact Information" on page 2). Note: Applications MUST be filed separately for each National Championship and received by the appropriate deadline (see below).

DEADLINES – Applications and supporting documents must be received no later than five (5) days after the entry deadline for the tournament for which the wild card is sought. Early application is strongly encouraged.

USTA NATIONAL OPENS

DEFINITION – USTA National Opens are held four times per year in each division: February, May, July and November. At each of these times, four simultaneous 64-draw tournaments will be held in different regions of the country. The top three singles finishers and the doubles finalists

qualify for the subsequent USTA National Championship, however they must submit timely entries to be accepted. See "USTA National Championships" on page 8.

ELIGIBILITY: Players who meet the U.S. citizenship or residency requirements, age eligibility requirements and membership requirements (current USTA membership) may enter.

ENTRY PROCEDURES – Players must enter using TennisLink. See "Entering Tournaments on the National Junior Tournament Schedule" on page 5. When registering on TennisLink, you **MUST** indicate your preferred site or sites in priority order. Players should list all sites to which they would be willing to travel. Players may enter only one division. A player who is entered in more than one division when entries close shall not be accepted into any division and their entry fees will not be refunded.

SELECTION PROCEDURE – Players are accepted into the draws and given preference in their choice of site in the following order:

- up to 224 players (up to 56 per draw) from the most recently published National Standings List for the division in the order in which their names appear on this list;
- up to 32 players (up to 8 per draw) from the top 200 players on the most recently published National Standings List of the next-younger division in the order in which their names appear on this list;
- players not yet in the draw whose names appear on the most recently published National Standings List of the division in the order in which their names appear on this list;
- players not yet in the draw whose names appear on the most recently National Standings List of the next-younger division in the order in which their names appear on this list; and
- the remaining entrants in the order of the strength of their records.

Players not selected for their first choice shall remain in the pool of applicants for entry into other concurrent USTA National Opens. Those players who have not been selected after all four USTA National Open draws have been filled shall be placed in alternate pools at all concurrent USTA National Opens for which the players indicated a preference.

ALTERNATES: Tournament Committees shall order the alternates as follows:

- players whose names appear in the database used for preparing the National Standings List of the age division shall be placed at the top of the list in the order in which their names appear in the database as of the date of the National Standings List used to select players into the USTA National Opens;
- players whose names appear in the database used for preparing the National Standings List of the next-younger age division shall be placed directly below the first group of players in the order in which their names appear in the database as of the date of the National Standings List used to select players into the USTA National Opens; and
- players whose names do not appear in the database used for preparing the National Standings Lists of the age division and of the next-younger age division shall be placed directly below the second group of players in an order determined by lot.

ONLINE SELECTION NOTIFICATION: Main draw players and alternates can view lists published to the TennisLink Tournament Home Page no later than five days after the entries close. Alternates will appear on the alternate lists at all sites they have prioritized. Alternates selected to fill openings in the draw will be contacted by the Tournament Committee. Go to www.USTA.com, click on Tournaments and locate the tournament using the Searchable Schedule.

SITE ASSIGNMENT FINAL: Once a player has been accepted into a USTA National Open, the player shall not be eligible for play in any other USTA National Open held during the same time, except that a player may submit a written request to move to another site within the same division if the draw at the requested site is not full, the request is received by each Tournament Director no later than 10 days before the start date of the tournament, and each Tournament Director involved understands the circumstances and concurs in writing.

DOUBLES ENTRY PROCEDURES: The entry deadline for the doubles event at USTA National Opens is on the day of registration and the time is set by the Tournament Committee – see the Tennislink Tournament Homepage for information.

ITF TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

AGE ELIGIBILITY – 18 DIVISION: The ITF employs a “year of birth” age eligibility rule. This is NOT the same “month of birth” age eligibility rule used for USTA tournaments. Juniors may play the 18s division until the YEAR in which they turn 19. Juniors must be born between January 1, 1989 and December 31, 1994 to enter an ITF tournament.

AGE ELIGIBILITY – 16, 14, AND 12 DIVISIONS: While some ITF tournaments hold events in the 16s, 14s, and 12s divisions, these tournaments are technically not ITF tournaments and earn no ITF points. These include the Orange Bowl, the Eddie Herr, the Prince Cup, the Kentucky Derby, and the USTA International Spring Championships. Juniors may play the 16s, 14s or 12s division until the YEAR in which they turn 13, 15, or 17, respectively.

16’s Division: Born between January 1, 1991 and December 31, 1994

14’s Division: Born between January 1, 1993 and December 31, 1994

12’s Division: Born January 1, 1995 or later

COMPETITION & RANKING YEAR: January 1, 2007 to December 31, 2007.

ITF TOURNAMENTS OUTSIDE THE U.S.: For endorsement into ITF tournaments held outside the US, please contact the Coordinator of Player Services, USTA Player Development. All players must be endorsed by the USTA to enter these tournaments. See “Contact Information” on page 2.

U.S. OPEN JUNIOR TENNIS CHAMPIONSHIPS – INFORMATION FOR U.S. PLAYERS: Players who meet U.S. citizenship or residency requirements should request an entry form for the U.S. Open from the Coordinator of Player Services, USTA Player Development. See “Contact Information” on page 2. The entry deadline is August 3, 2007.

U.S. OPEN JUNIOR TENNIS CHAMPIONSHIPS – INFORMATION FOR NON-U.S. PLAYERS: Players who do not meet US citizenship or residency requirements must obtain entry forms and endorsement from their respective Federations. The entry deadline is August 3, 2007.

OTHER ITF TOURNAMENTS WITHIN THE U.S.: For endorsement into ITF held tournaments in the US, junior players should apply directly to the USTA Junior Competition office. See “Contact Information” on page 2. For more information on ITF tournaments within the United States please visit the following website: www.usta.com/itftournaments.

SELECTION CRITERIA FOR BOYS’ AND GIRLS’ 18 ITF TOURNAMENTS: Junior players will be selected based on ITF rankings, ATP/WTA rankings, and/or USTA national junior rankings by the Tournament Committee.

BOYS’ AND GIRLS’ 16, 14 and 12 ITF TOURNAMENTS: players will be selected based on ITF rankings and USTA national junior rankings.

UPDATING PLAYER RECORDS

REVIEWING RECORDS: Players are responsible for regularly reviewing their national singles and doubles player records and should promptly submit corrections to the USTA Junior and Collegiate Competition Department (see “Contact Information” on page 2). It is recommended that players review their records after each tournament they play – tournament results are typically posted no more than one week after the completion of a tournament. All corrections must be submitted no later than January 28 to be considered for the previous calendar year’s final year-end ranking.

FINDING YOUR RECORD ONLINE: To find your player record online, go to www.USTA.com and click on Rankings. Click on the posting for viewing National Standings Lists and Rankings. Select your division to view the appropriate list. Click on your name to view your record. If you appear on two separate lists, you must go to each list to review your record for the division. Only tournaments that count toward your standing or ranking will appear.

USTA NATIONAL JUNIOR RANKINGS

CALCULATION OF SINGLES RANKING: Each player's annual singles ranking will be based on the accumulation of points for winning rounds ("Points Per Round") and having wins over "top 100" players ("Bonus Points") at National Ranking Tournaments during the calendar year. Players must accumulate at least 200 ranking points during the calendar year in order to earn a year-end ranking. The total number of points a player earns during the year is determined as follows:

Points Earned at 8 Best
National Ranking Tournaments**

+ Bonus Points Earned at BG 18 ITF Bonus
Point-Only Events on the National Junior
Tournament Schedule

= Total Ranking Points

** Points Earned include Points Per Round from the Point Ranking Tables below PLUS any Bonus Points earned at the tournament. These Bonus Points are "attached" to the event at which they are earned. If a tournament is not among a player's best eight tournaments, neither the Points Per Round nor the Bonus Points for that event will count toward the player's ranking point total.

A list of the National Ranking Tournaments is in the table under "National Ranking Tournaments and Tournament Levels" below. Because 12 Sectional events are designated National Ranking Tournaments, it is possible for a player to earn a national ranking by playing only in Sectional tournaments.

Calculation of Doubles Ranking: The method for calculating doubles rankings and standings will be the same as for singles EXCEPT that Bonus Points will not be used.

The USTA will rank players in doubles in two ways:

- Players will be ranked individually based on the accumulation of points for winning rounds at National Ranking Tournaments during the year. This ranking will be based on points a player earns playing with various partners. An individual doubles player will earn all of the points in the ranking point tables below, the points are not split between partners.
- Players will be ranked as teams based on the accumulation of points for winning rounds as a team at National Ranking Tournaments during the year.

SPECIFICS OF THE POINTS PER ROUND NJRS INCLUDE:

- A player must win a round to receive any points for the tournament. The points tables that appear below are based on draws as large as 256 players. In draws smaller than 256 players, players do not receive any points until they have won a round. Byes do not qualify as wins.
- Withdrawals and walkovers qualify as wins for the advancing player and earn Points Per Round, but do not earn Bonus Points.
- Retirements qualify as wins for the advancing player and earn Points Per Round and, if eligible, Bonus Points.
- A player who advances because of a default that takes place before the commencement of the first point in the match or because the opponent is disqualified shall receive Points Per Round for advancing, but shall not receive any Bonus Points.
- A player who advances because of a default that takes place after the commencement of the first point in the match shall receive Points Per Round for advancing and, if eligible, Bonus Points.
- A player who is defaulted from a tournament for code violations under the Point Penalty System or misconduct forfeits any points accumulated during the tournament, including both Points Per Round and Bonus Points. Players defaulted in singles only lose points accumulated for play in the singles main and feed-in championship draws.
- No Points Per Round will be earned in the qualifying rounds of tournaments when the qualifying draw and main draw are covered in a single sanction. However, Level 1 through 5 tournaments, Bonus Points will accumulate for the tournament and will be attached to the tournament at which they are earned. Additionally, American juniors winning matches against

other American juniors at the Australian Open, French Open, Wimbledon, and Canadian Open will receive Bonus Points that will be added to the player's total points earned at the player's best eight tournaments. See "Bonus Points – Rewards for Significant Wins" below.

- The final rankings for a junior age division shall include all players who have been age eligible for play in the division at any time during the year and who have accumulated at least 200 points in the division. Only points earned in the division will count towards ranking in that division. Players may be ranked in more than one age division if they have been age eligible in more than one division during the year and have met the minimum point requirement for each age division.

NATIONAL RANKING TOURNAMENTS AND TOURNAMENT LEVELS: Below are the National Ranking Tournaments that will count for ranking in 2006. The table also includes the tournament "Level" that corresponds with the National Ranking Point Tables that follow.

BONUS POINTS – REWARDS FOR SIGNIFICANT WINS: Bonus Points are earned at National Ranking Tournaments for significant wins over top 100 players according to the table below. Bonus Points are earned for wins in both main draw and qualifying draw matches. At Level 1 through 5 tournaments, Bonus Points are "attached" to the tournament at which they are earned. If a tournament total is not among a player's best eight tournaments, neither the Points Per Round nor the Bonus Points will count toward the player's ranking point total. Additionally, American juniors winning matches against other American juniors in the main draw and qualifying rounds at the Australian Open, French Open, Wimbledon, and Canadian Open will receive Bonus Points in the 18s division according to the Bonus Points table below. These Bonus Points will be awarded independent of the best eight tournaments and will be added to the player's total points earned in the player's best eight tournaments.

PUBLICATION OF TENTATIVE AND FINAL NATIONAL JUNIOR RANKINGS

TENTATIVE RANKINGS: This is the first ranking determined by junior ranking committees for both singles and doubles play. The tentative junior rankings shall be published by January 15 of each year. These tentative junior rankings have no official standing until certified by the Junior Ranking Review Board.

CORRECTIONS TO PLAYER RECORD: Any corrections to a player's record must be received by the USTA Junior and Collegiate Competition Department no later January 30 of each year. See "Contact Information" on page 2.

FINAL RANKINGS: These are the singles and doubles rankings in all divisions that have been certified as official USTA rankings by the Junior Ranking Review Board and shall be subsequently published in the *USTA Yearbook*. These final junior rankings are determined after corrections have been received and acted upon by junior ranking committees. Final junior rankings are not subject to appeal.

USTA ANTI-DOPING PROGRAM

The USTA is committed to ensure fair and drug-free competition. Individual athletes bear the ultimate responsibility to choose for themselves to compete fairly and drug-free. Participation in USTA tournaments constitutes consent to be tested for drugs. Use of banned substances and doping methods is cheating and may result in penalties including suspension and permanent disqualification. The USTA has developed a program of education, testing, research, penalties, and rehabilitation. The Board has adopted and supports the USTA Program of Drug Education,

Testing, and Penalties. Information about this program may be obtained from the USA Tennis High Performance Sport Science Department and USTA Sectional offices. See "Contact Information" on page 2. It can also be viewed on the USTA website at www.USTA.com.

COMBINED RANKING SYSTEM(NEW FOR 2007)

The United States Tennis Association has approved a change in the ranking system for juniors that will take effect on January 1, 2008. In 2008, the USTA will no longer publish individual singles and doubles standings and rankings. Instead, the USTA will publish a combined ranking, which includes results from singles and doubles. The USTA is making this change to encourage players to play more doubles and to reward players for their success in doubles. Moreover, the USTA feels playing doubles will help players with their overall development.

How it works

The new ranking system will include results from singles matches and doubles matches in all tournaments that are now included in the calculations for the National Standing List and the year-end National Ranking. The points earned in singles competition will be combined with the points earned in doubles competition to form one final point total that will be used for the National Standing List and the National Ranking. Players will receive credit for 100% of their singles points from their best eight (8) events along with 15% of their doubles points from their best eight (8) doubles events. The chart below describes how the system will work:

<p>Player X (a player with better singles results) Best eight (8) singles tournaments = 1500 points Best eight (8) doubles tournaments = 1200 points 15% of 1200 = 180 points 1500 + 180 = 1680 total combined ranking points</p>

<p>Player Y (a player with better doubles results) Best eight (8) singles tournaments = 1200 points Best eight (8) doubles tournaments = 1500 points 15% of 1500 = 225 points 1200 + 225 = 1425 total combined ranking points</p>

Preliminary Lists

Throughout 2007, the National Standing List and year-end National Rankings will be published as normal. Tracking of results for the calculation the combined ranking will begin on January 1, 2007. The USTA will publish a preliminary unofficial National Standing List in June 2007 so that players

can see where they would stand under the Combined Ranking. Thereafter a new preliminary unofficial National Standing List will be published monthly.

The first official list with the Combined Rankings will be published on Wednesday, January 2, 2008. This list will include all events that would be normally included in the calculation of the National Standing List from January 2, 2007. Monthly bonus point lists will be published as scheduled using the Combined Rankings. Tournament acceptance lists and alternate lists will be created using the National Standing List of combined rankings.

Doubles Promotion

Throughout 2007 there will be more information on the efforts to promote and encourage doubles play. It is anticipated that Sections may implement doubles-only tournaments to encourage play and give players valuable point earning opportunities.
